Poetry & Pasties

Next week, we are launching our annual poetry competition. Children will be able to recite a poem and/or submit a poem they have written at school or at home. The list of poems that the children can choose from will be released on Monday during assembly. They will also be available from Reception, from class teachers and from the school Moodle.

On Tuesday, we welcome back Steve Tasane, the performance poet who visited us last year. Steve will be spending the day with us. The day will also be peppered by visits from the Poetry Squad; local poetry enthusiasts who will be performing some of their favourite poems during visits to classes.

The competition itself will be held after half-term, on Friday, 3rd November. This year, instead of inviting parents of winners into the celebration assembly that day, we are putting on a special event a week later, 'Poetry & Pasties'. Local butcher, Michael Courtney has agreed to make pasties for children (£1.00) and adults (£2.50). We will have another performance poet, Justin Coe, at the evening and everybody is welcome to come and they can read or perform a poem that they would like to share. However, we need to know numbers of pasties needed, so please let the office know if you would like to reserve a pasty – the deadline is November 1st. We very much hope that all winners in the poetry competition will recite the poems that they learnt or read the poems that they wrote.

Starting School September 2018

If your child was born between 1st September 2013 and 31st August 2014 they can start school in September 2018. From Monday 2nd October 2017 to Monday 15th January 2018, you can apply online on the pupil Admissions Application website at www.westsussex.gov.uk. Once you have submitted your online application you will receive an automatic email acknowledgement. Free internet access to apply online is available at all West Sussex libraries and Children and Family Centres. Paper forms will only be issued to parents on request by phoning 0333 0142903 and forms need to be sent by recorded delivery. Applications made after the closing date cannot be considered until all other applications have been dealt with. Online applicants will be notified which school their child has been offered by email during the day of Monday 16th April 2018. Other applicants will be sent a letter by second class post, posted on 16th April.
