Dear Parent/Carer

I hope you have had a good Christmas break, though I know that some of our families have had positive COVID tests and have had to self-isolate.

With the new term ahead, cases of the Omicron variant steadily increasing and new guidance from the Government, please find attached a revised risk assessment for the start of term. It remains a significant document, but the changes are highlighted in yellow to make it more digestible. There are some key requests that I would like to remind you about:

- Be alert to the symptoms and, if in any doubt, keep your child at home to avoid risking infection of your child's class
- Keep the office informed if your child has symptoms, is awaiting results or has had a result, whether negative or positive
- Avoid congregating at drop-off/pick-up
- Wear masks when dropping off and picking up
- Drop off/pick up alone, i.e. without other adults in the family
- Keep your children by your side at drop-off until the school doors open
- Consider letting your child (if in Otters or Foxes) to walk in, unaccompanied – if you have no younger children, use the drop-off zone if driving
- Where possible, communicate with the school via e-mail or telephone
- If you do need to come into school, wear a mask and use sanitiser
